## Our Main Liaison: William W. Forgey, M.D., CCHP

- William W. Forgey, M.D., CCHP, is a Past President of the Wilderness Medical Society. The author of over 30 published books with his third book being Wilderness Medicine in 1979. Dr. Forgey is currently the Boy Scouts of America Wilderness First Aid National Task Force Chairman and a member of the Board of Directors of the International Association for Medical Assistance to Travelers ([www.iamat.org](http://www.iamat.org)). He edited three editions of the published Wilderness Medical Society Practice Guidelines. He holds national awards from the Wilderness Medical Society, the Wilderness Education Association, the Student Conservation Association, and was honored as the Alpha-Omega-Alpha Volunteer Teacher of the Year in 2000 by the Indiana University School of Medicine.



## Trip Dates:

**December 25<sup>th</sup> or 26<sup>th</sup> - December 30<sup>th</sup> 2017**

- Students have the choice to arrive in Haiti on either of the above dates. \*



## December 2017 Trip Cost:

**\$425 per student** - includes all inside Haiti costs.

Prices do not include: **AIRFARE**, \$10 cash visa entry fee at Port-Au-Prince airport (PAP), or travel insurance.

This trip fee is **non-refundable** but could be applied towards another trip with Medical Student Missions at a future time.



# What Will We Be Doing?

- The group will be divided into small teams consisting of **1-2 students, a nurse, and a translator.**
- You will be working **DIRECTLY** with the patients to obtain the history and chief complaint. (May be able to do vitals/physical exams depending on state of the patient as well as students' own skill level.)
- You will present your case to the attending who will help you come up with an assessment & plan for the patient.

**Students will also be needed to help run the pharmacy and lab.**
