Dr. Fox provides comprehensive obstetrical care and high-risk pregnancy consultations at Maternal Fetal Medicine Associates as well as diagnostic ultrasound, fetal diagnosis, and invasive procedures at Carnegie Imaging for Women. He is also actively involved in research,

with a particular focus on multiple gestation, diagnostic ultrasound, and preterm birth, and has authored many peer-reviewed publications. Dr. Fox is on the editorial board of Obstetrics & Gynecology, the premier OBGYN research journal in the United States. Dr. Fox has won several teaching awards for resident and medical student education, and serves as a research mentor and teacher for students in middle school, high school, college, medical school, and residency.
